


# COST OF DATA BREACH

## **DATA BREACH COST IN UK**

On average, a Data Breach costs UK enterprises £2.56m, the global average has risen 1.6% from 2018 to 2019, reaching £2.97m per breach. Cyber attackers usually target SMEs that often do not have strong cybersecurity.



#### **COVID-19 & DATA BREACH**

Remote work became a significant factor of increased cyber attacks: Recently cyber attacks include impersonating the <u>World Health</u> Organization.



## **AVERAGE TIME TO IDENTIFY AND CONTAIN A DATA BREACH IN 2019**

The <u>average time</u> to identify and contain a data breach is 280 days. Companies that had invested in cybersecurity services significantly minimized data breach costs.



#### RANSOMWARE

It is estimated that the cost of ransomware to businesses will top \$20 billion in companies should engage in regular pen testing.



## **DETERIORATION OF BRAND** REPUTATION

A third of UK Businesses (33%) said they lost customers after a cyber attack that was not handled appropriately. Over a fifth (23%) lost revenue.



# 4.1 BILLION, EXPOSED RECORDS FROM **DATA BREACHES IN 2019**

The approximate global cost of each record is cost of each record 150\$ which increases to 429\$ in healthcare and in finance 210\$.



### **PHISHING**

<u>1.5 million</u> new phishing sites are created every month. Employees need to be educated to reduce the risk of a compromise. Experience shows that professional training is the most effective. 35% of data breaches were attributed to human error or negligence
